

# Rhymes Roaming Round

## Rhyme Production

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C F C G C F C F Am

Let's play a game, a rhym-ing game. Change the be-gin-ning but the end stays the same.

G *a tempo* C D G C Dm G C

I'll use the al-pha-bet to help me find all of the rhym-ing words roam-ing 'round my mind.

C F C Am G C F C G C

A is a vowel and B is (bat), C is (cat) and D is (dat).  
E is a vowel and F is (fat), G is (gat) and H is (hat).  
I is a vowel and J is (jat), K is (kat) and L is (lat).

C F C Am G C F C G C

M is (mat) and N is (nat), O is a vowel and P is (pat).  
Q is (qat) and R is (rat), S is (sat) and T is (tat).  
U is a vowel and V is (vat), W is (wat) and X is (xat).

G C G C G7 C

Y is (yat), — but some-times it's a vowel. And what is Z? — Z is (zat)!

Using a large dry erase board, write the letters from a-z down the left side and a rime like “at” or “op” on the right side. It is helpful to write the vowels in a different color.
