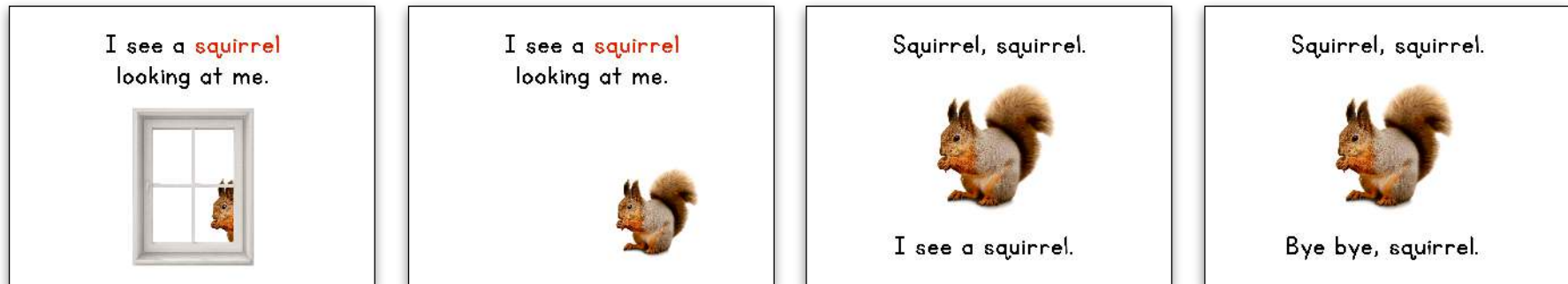

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DIRECTIONS:

- Write child's name in each blank or print on another piece paper and glue in place. The font used is KG Primary Penmanship 2. The font size is 65 pt.
- Cut out the four window panes on page 2, leaving the white border.
- Glue or print the music on the BACK of the final page so that you can see it while holding up the book for your students.
- It is recommended that you bind the book at the BOTTOM of the book for easy turning of pages. A comb binding works well. You can also use a simple 3-hole punch and 3/4" hinged rings.
